

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON
LAW AND ORDER/SECURITY ISSUES
DC'S CHAMBER, 11th March 2015**

A meeting on the law and order situation of Seppa Township, with particular reference to the Market areas, was held in the office chamber of the DC, East Kameng, Seppa on 11th March 2015. Chaired by Mr. Sandeep Kumar Singh, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, East Kameng, the meeting was attended by the following:

Extensive discussions yielded the following issues and the actions necessary thereof.

1. Voluntary Public Vigilance by EKCC&I and BWC:

East Kameng Chamber of Commerce and Industry (EKCC&I) and the Bazar Welfare Committee (BWC), Seppa shall endeavour to promote responsible vigilance by its members to deal with incidents of extortion and intimidation of the trading community of Seppa. All the office bearers of the two organisations shall be involved and specific tasks delegated to them in this regard. A list of such members, and the duties assigned to them shall be submitted to the DC, East Kameng at the earliest.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: EKCC&I AND BWC

2. Filing of FIR:

EKCC&I and BWC should be bold in its outlook and file all complaints and FIRs on behalf of the harassed trading community, most of whom are non-locals.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: EKCC&I AND BWC

3. Patrolling of Public Places :

Public premises such as the General Ground, Circuit House, School compounds, Medical Compound and Pacha Hydel compound should be covered during rounds by the patrolling teams to ensure they are free of nuisance-makers. Reasonable action may be taken against persons found loitering, drinking in public and indulging in other undesirable actions, especially in the night time.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: POLICE/CAPF PATROLLING TEAMS

4. Action against Suspected Extortionists:

Names of persons suspected of extortion/intimidation of the traders of Seppa township should be forwarded to the Deputy Commissioner, Seppa for further action, including binding down the individuals under section 107 CrPC.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: EKCC&I

5. **Medical Examination of Arrestees:**

Propos the legal obligation to medically examine arrestees, certain limitations have been detected in the earlier instruction to set up a board in each and every case. In this regard, a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) shall be prepared for all future courses of action.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: CIRCLE OFFICER (JUDICIAL)

6. **CCTV Cameras in the Market Areas:**

EKCC&I shall at the earliest convene meetings/workshops to sensitise the traders of the township about the advantages of installing CCTV cameras inside individual shops. Further, the possibility of setting up external CCTV cameras in main Bazar line (and elsewhere) shall be explored. A concept paper prepared a few years back in this regard shall be re-looked at.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: EKCC&I and CIRCLE OFFICER (JUDICIAL)

7. **Closure of Country Liquor Sheds:**

It has been seen that incidents of crime and disturbance of public peace are created by persons under the influence of country liquor (*Apong*). Therefore, the earlier executive order, prohibiting the sale of country liquor in the township shall be enforced strictly. Raids shall be conducted by teams of at least one section of security personnel, led by a responsible Police Officer and a Magistrate. Premises of all country liquor sheds shall be sealed, violators of the order apprehended, and FIRs filed at the Police Station, Seppa.

TASK TO BE PERFORMED BY: MAGISTRATES & DISTRICT POLICE


