

DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES FOR THE SESSION -2014-15.

A maiden meeting with the newly formed members of School Management and Development Committee of Govt. Hr. Sec. School, Seppa, District, East Kameng, A.P. was held on 19/08/2014 at 1530 hrs in the DC's Office, Kameng Hall, under the Chairmanship of Shri Sandeep Kumar Singh, IAS, the Deputy Commissioner, East Kameng, Dist. A.P. who is too the Chairman of School Management and Development Committee (SMDC) to discuss on various developmental activities of the school including the modus operandi for the utilization of School fund for the academic session 2014-15.

At the very outset while Principal giving the welcome Address, Shri Babom Bam, the Principal, Govt. Hr. Sec. School, Seppa, welcomed all the members of School Management and Development Committee (SMDC) present in the house and highlighted the aims and objectives of the meeting.

Shri Jorjo Sono Yangfo, J/T the Vice Principal I/c Govt. Hr. Sec. School, Seppa, while addressing the members of the house, he presented a brief report of the School referring to the post and pre situations of the School focussing mainly on the collection of School fund & its misused by the then School Captain. He further informed the house that in the current session 2014-15, the School fund has been collected by the School @ Rs 120/ per head from the existing strength of 1687 students in the school as per the direction of DSE order No.EDA/144/2013 dated 17<sup>th</sup> June 2013 & except it, no other extra fund has been raised by the school for running the school activities for the entire session. However, the school captain & its members of school welfare committee are putting heavy pressure on the Principal & Vice Principal for handing over some percentage of amount to them for their vested interest citing the traditional example of the previous captains and the Principal are made our best efforts to convince them that from this academic session, no other fund raise except the fixed amount of the school fund meant for the running the school activities including the conduct of various stages of examinations of the school but our all persuasions and advices fell flat. Hence, he (V.P) appealed to the Chairman and House members to frame a guideline in this context.

The Deputy Commissioner cum Chairman, SMDC Seppa, going through minutely over the records related to the collection of school fees and allocation of fund in the different heads for running the school for the academic session 2014-15, expressed his full satisfaction with a

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of the money raised by the school captain & his team. Instead, they might place the indent of the articles/materials for holding any activities of the school in writing undersigned to the Principal for further approval by him (DC cum Chairman). If felt necessary, it can be approved, else be turned down. He cautioned them not to demand and collect any fund illegally which may lead to a case of extortion.

Further the Chairman lamented that almost all the Govt. Schools are facing much hardship in the lack of resources due to which the affordable guardian parents used to put up their words in the wellfurnished private institutions, but it is not possible for all the guardian/parents who run in the financial constrained. However, he advises the students that they must engage in the study and take optimum advantages from the well experienced teachers. If they fail to do so, others may take advantages in the different jobs in place of them as it is looking in the present time in the East Kameng District.

Regarding the encroachment of land in the school campus, he disclosed in the house that the matters have been referred to the ADC, Seppa to find the means and ways for settling such a grave issues.

On the issue of lack of infrastructure, the Chairman appealed to the ZPMs being the members of the SMDC of GHSSS to meet up some of genuine problems from their own level to administer the academic classes of the school.

From his own side, he announced on the floor of the house to donate/provide 100 pairs of desk and bench to school as immediate relief.

Regarding the requirement of the teachers for the subjects PCB, PCM, English & post of lab assistants, the Chairman said that he had much discussion with the DSE and Education Commissioner, Itanagar to post the required numbers of the teachers in East Kameng District for running the Secondary level classes.

Other members of SMDC, GHSSS like Shri B.G. Sonam, ZPM cum vice Chairman of SMDC, Shri Dadi Rimo, ZPM, Shri Demo Gyadi, ZPM, Shri Radha Flago, ASM, also spoke on the maiden meeting of the SMDC. They expressed their deep concern on the pitiable condition of the oldest institution of East Kameng, District, with the unanimous voice they appealed to the Deputy Commissioner, Seppa to nab the culprit who indulged in the fire accident of the school as early as possible so that an exemplary punishment can be awarded to them by the court. They also advised the teachers to be regular & punctual in the school and guide the students properly. They further stated that the students must do the social service in the school without any gain treating the school as their temple.

On the issue of infrastructure of the school, they pointed out that they have been in touch with all the Hon'ble MLAs of East Kameng District and very soon, the problems of the basic needs of the school can be fulfilled.

Some of the matters raised by the Girls Hostel Monitress, such as vehicle problem for lifting the firewood, collection of ration, vegetable etc, and the members of SDMC assured her to meet up her genuine problem very soon.

On the issue of sanitation raised by the school captain, the members assured him to solve the sanitation problems of the school through the sanitation scheme as now it is available.


Thus through the marathon discussions on the school activities and utilization of school fund, the members of the SMDC gave their consensus unanimously on the following points: -

1. The executive body of the school welfare Committee shall not be allowed to handle the school fee/school fund in cash.
2. No any kinds of parties shall be organised by the members of the executive body of SWC & the students of the school on the cost of school fund on so.
3. The executive body of SWC wish to conduct any activities in the school such as literary programme games & sports cultural etc, they have to place their indent of articles/materials in writing before

the Principal or concern in charge which will move through file for final approval of Deputy Commissioner, Seppa.

4. Any students/members of SWC found involve in money matters or illegally raising the fund can be treated a case of extortion.
5. No student will disturb the conducive atmosphere of the school and torture/harass the teachers and principal/vice Principal, if any are found in such rigorous activities, the members of the SDMC will take stern action including the expulsion from the school.
6. The Principal will make transparency in the utilization of school fund and time to time it shall be placed for the audit.
7. Any problems faced by the school should be brought to the notice of the Deputy Commissioner, Seppa and the members of SDMC for finding the remedies.
8. The members of SDMC are to visit the school time to time to collect the information of the school and guide the students.

At last, Shri D.B. Sirigh S/T member of SDMC GHSSS gave a vote of thanks with an appealed to the members of SDMC to visit the school occasionally to guide and suggest the students, teachers and the school authority to run the school in congenial atmosphere with such the meeting end.
